

## **DRESS CODE**

Sherwood Park Elementary has a Uniform Dress Code. All students are required to adhere to the prescribed dress guidelines.

Belts: Belts are required for ALL students wearing pants, skirts, shorts, or skorts with belt loops.

### **Girls:**

Shirts: Collared, sleeved polo style

(or turtleneck) shirts in navy blue, plain white or light (Carolina) blue.

(Must be long enough to be tucked in to the pants.)

Slacks, shorts, skorts, and jumpers: khaki, navy, or black

Shoes: Rubbersoled

shoes (No flip flops, wheelies, or high heels)

Socks: ankle, knee high, tights, hose (Non decorative) colors: white, black, navy, khaki, or tan

Sweaters: Navy, black, or white (pullover or cardigan)

### **Boys:**

Shirts: Collared, sleeved polo style,

turtlenecks, or oxford style

shirts in navy blue, plain white or light

(Carolina) blue. (Must be long enough to be tucked in to the pants.)

Slacks/shorts: khaki, navy, or black

Shoes: rubbersoled

shoes (No flip flops or wheelies)

Socks: ankle or knee (nondecorative)

colors: white, black, navy, khaki, or tan

Sweaters: plain navy, black, or white (Pullover or cardigan)

### **Guidelines:**

All students: If a student needs to wear a sweater or jacket in the classroom, it must be a uniform color.

Winter coats do not have to be uniform colors but will not be worn during class time. These coats will only

be worn for outdoor recess or PE and during travel/transitioning. SWPES spirit shirts can be worn on

Mondays with uniform bottoms. Class college shirts/colors may be worn on Fridays with uniform pants.

Students will be allowed to wear casual attire on special occasions, such as dance and picture days. "Dress

Down" days will also be used as an incentive for PBIS performance. On Dress Down days, please make

sure your child complies with the dress code of SWPES.

In addition:

**1. Belts must be worn with all pants, skirts, and skorts that have belt loops.**

2. Shorts must pass "the fingertip" test in the front and the back.

3. Clothing must NOT depict intoxicating beverages, weapons or be suggestive of violence or obscenities.

4. Hats, caps, scarves, bandanas, or any type of head coverings are not to be worn into the school.

**Consequences of noncompliance

- 1<sup>st</sup> Offense: Telephone notification to parent
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: Written warning home to parent
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: Shortterm

suspension or other disciplinary measure
