Questions to get your child to tell you about their day:

Classwork:

- What work did you do today?
- What was your favorite work?
- What was the easiest thing you did?
- What was the hardest?
- Is there anything you wish you could do over again?

Lunch:

- What was your favorite thing that you ate for lunch?
- Who did you sit next to?

Relationships:

- Who did you help today? Who helped you?
- Who made you feel happy/sad?
- Who did you play with outside?
- Who do you think needs a friend?

Random:

- What do you wish you could have done today?
- Who would you ask for help if you needed help with Math? Reading a word? Spelling?
- What can you do to be nice to someone tomorrow?

*Tip - Start bedtime 15 minutes early and use this time to ask about their day. Most students love to stall bedtime and will chat up a storm.
